

**The Commons Act 2006, application under Section 19
The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.
Application to correct the register of common land by the addition of land at
Church Common.**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by the Ringland Parish Council to Norfolk County Council as Commons Registration Authority, to add land to the register of common land at Church Common, Ringland as hatched black on the plan which accompanied the application and which is attached to this Notice.

A summary of the effect of the application under Section 19 is as follows: the land as hatched black was not included by the Commons Registration Authority when it provisionally registered, on 26 July 1968, Church Hill Common as common land under section 4 of the 1965 Act. This provisional registration, being undisputed, became final on 1 August 1972. This application will add the land hatched black to the common land registers for Church Common, Ringland.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by adding the land to the register of common land



- Must state the grounds on which they were made and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential but will be dealt with in accordance with regulation 25. If the application is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination in accordance with regulation 26, any representations will be sent with it for consideration. The date on which the period for making representations expires is 18 September 2015.

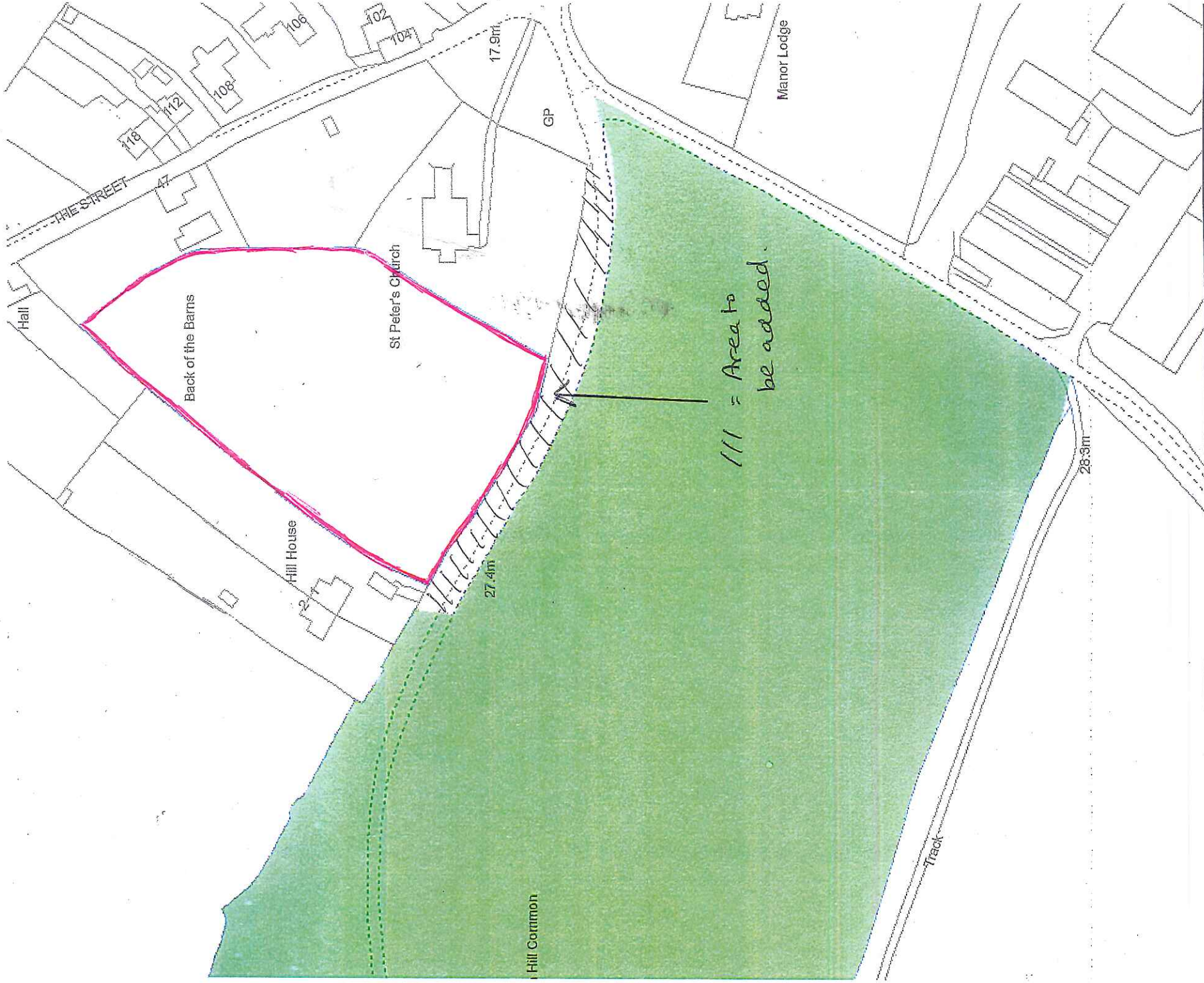
