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Pavement Maintenance **St Hugh's Green, Gorleston**

Essential pavement maintenance works on St Hugh's Green, Gorleston, will begin on 3 June 2024. The work is expected to last 15 weeks, weather permitting, and will see old paving slabs replaced with an asphalt surface. Site Location Plan showing the work extents is attached in Appendix A.

To ensure the works are carried out safely, a road closure will be required along St Hugh's Green. The point of closure will be next to the pavement works and will move as the work progresses. A fully signed diversion route will be in place for this.

Vehicular and pedestrian access to properties will be maintained at all times – site staff will endeavour to make any delays as short as possible.

Throughout the works we will require an area for the site compound to store tools and materials. The land we have chosen to do this on is highlighted in the attached plan.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while these maintenance works are carried out.

Works are expected to cost £244,000 and will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
