## TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Festival Too Lazy Sunday, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be a temporary suspension of parking bays and temporary creation of urban clearway on U20501 Purfleet Place (full length); U20504 Kings Staithe Square (full length); U20503 Kings Staithe Lane (U20546 South Quay in an easterly direction to junction U20504 Kings Staithe Square); U20546 South Quay (junction U20504 Kings Staithe Square in a southerly direction to junction U20508 College Lane) in the PARISH OF KING'S LYNN.

The Order will come into effect on Sunday 30 June 2024 and will remain in force for 10 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Sunday 30 June 2024 between 11:00hrs and 21:00hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure, temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed
