IN THE BOROUGH OF GREAT YARMOUTH ON SUNDAY 14 JULY 2024

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the NSRA Show and Shine (supporting East Anglian Air Ambulance) Event, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C629 Marine Parade, from its junction with U60492 Trafalgar Road, heading north for 352m; and C629 Regent Road, from its junction with C629 Marine Parade, heading west for 270m in the BOROUGH of GREAT YARMOUTH.

The Order will come into effect on Sunday 14 July 2024 and will remain in force for **9 hours**. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Sunday 14 July 2024 between **8am to 5pm**. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed
