ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 16A AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994 IN THE PARISH OF LUDHAM ON SUNDAY 30 JUNE 2024

TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate Ludham Open Gardens, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the following roads:

- U19124 Horsefen Road from the fork in Horsefen Road, 50 metres south from the A1062 heading south for 905 metres to the end of Horsefen Road outside Hunter's Yard.
- U19032 Staithe Road from its junction with A1062 heading south for 530 metres to a point 10 metres north of its junction with Lovers Lane in the PARISH OF LUDHAM.

The Order will come into effect on Sunday 30 June 2024 and will remain in force for 9 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Sunday 30 June 2024 between 08:00hrs and 17:00hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure, temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.
