TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Outlaw Half Holkham Triathlon, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C88 Docking Road, junction with B1454 Docking Road in a southerly direction to junction with C91 Bircham Road (Temporary One-Way Restriction: restricting north-bound traffic) in the PARISH OF DOCKING.

The Order will come into effect on Sunday 7 July 2024 and will remain in force for 8 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Sunday 7 July 2024 between 06:00 hrs and 14:00 hrs. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure, temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed

Alternative route will be via: C88 Docking Road; C88 Sherborne Road; C86 Bircham Road; C89 Sedgeford Road; C89 Snettisham Road; B1454 Heacham Road; B1454 Cole Green; B1454 Docking Road; C88 Docking Road.
