A147 Chappelfield Road Road Rejuvanation works

The south side of A147 Chapelfield Road will be closed which includes a suspension of parking, on 30 June between the hours of 07:00 and 12:00, from St Stephens roundabout heading northwest to just before the second entrance to The Crescent. It is intended to apply a road rejuvenator which is sprayed onto the road surface and requires time to soak into the top layer.

Through this early intervention approach the road surface will last a number of years longer than without. Norfolk is following a regime of preserving our asphalt surfaces which is both good for the environment and good value for money.

A fully signed diversion route will be in operation for the duration of the works.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this work is carried out.

The work which will cost £17,400 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Infrastructure Department and their contractors.

This is an ongoing treatment used on parts of Norfolk's classified Network to prevent the surface layer deteriorating. The rejuvenator has a very low carbon footprint and is used to elongate the life of the very expensive surface asphalt layer.
