Road Closure at Acle Road Bridge TG41303 -Stokesby New Road, Fleggburgh

Stokesby New Road, Fleggburgh will be closed for 1 day on Monday 01 July 2024, with two way traffic lights operating on Main Road A1064/32, adjacent to the junction of Stokesby New Road. This is to allow for essential bridge repairs to be safely carried out.

The repair work will involve removing damaged fencing and debris, breaking out damaged fence from concrete headwall, replace railings and damaged concrete posts. For this work a full road closure, with two way lights is required to maintain a safe working area for our contractors.

A signed diversion route will be in place for the duration of the closure with pedestrian access being maintained at all times.

The County Council thanks people for their patience while this maintenance work is carried out.

The work which will cost £2,200 will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
