TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC MOVEMENT

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Food and Artisan Street Market, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily restrict vehicular traffic on the C536 High Street, from its junction with U11481 Lower Staithe Street, heading west for 430m. U19015 Bank Street from its junction with C421 Brumstead Road to its junction with C356 High Street. In the PARISH OF Stalham.

The Order will come into effect on Sunday 21 July 2024 and will remain in force for 10 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) on Sunday 21 July 2024 between 8am to 6pm. Restrictions on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.
