Temporary delays for vehicle access/egress using Steepgreen Close.

Works to improve the Carriageway on Steepgreen Close in Norwich are programmed to start on or soon after 1st July 2024. The work will involve the lowering of 2 inspection lids (manhole covers) and the level of the carriageway outside property number 5.

The works are expected to take 3 days to complete, weather permitting.

The works will extend from property number 5, for a length of approximately 15 meters to allow for our equipment Due to the location of the chambers (structures under the carriageway) and the carriageway width, there may be a short delay in accessing the properties during the works. Emergency services will be aware of the works in case they need access for their vehicles. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Team members will on hand to assist residents if required for the duration of the works. To minimise disruption, we will complete the work in two halves, working on the inspection chambers one at a time to allow traffic to pass either side. The County Council thanks people for their patience while this carriageway improvement work is carried out.

The work which will cost £1200, and will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
