Raynham Footpath 2 - Emergency Closure due to unsafe Bridge

Part of the above footpath has been closed as an emergency due to an inspection finding the main beams are rotten making it unsafe for the public to use.

The footpath is closed between the junction of Raynham Footpath 3 and Raynham Footpath 2, and the junction of Raynham Footpath 4 and Raynham Footpath 2, approximately 66 metres of footpath being closed. A diversion route is in place.

The bridge will be closed for the foreseeable future, while works are programmed and a new bridge is installed. The County Council thanks people for their patience while this issue is resolved.

The cost of the work will have to be confirmed at a later date, due to it being an emergency closure, will be carried out by Norfolk County Council's Community and Environmental Services Department and their contractors.
